

I did the grill screens on my 997-3 this weekend. Ryan's DIY on the grill screen removal is perfect. Follow his step by step. and it works just fine.

I am going to focus on the grill screens and attaching them to the bumper inserts. Starting with the Grill screen I had two types. I ordered some powdercoated screen from Customcargrills.com it was not good screen, but I just order stuff that was to course, I went with a finer stainless steel mesh from Pegasus racing.

After removal of the bumper I determined the best way to install was as others have done, Glue the screens to the air opening brackets they can be removed so you can work with cutting the screen carefully because you do not have a lot of room to play with. the area you have to glue to is vary small surface.





After I got the screens cut, I spend some time sanding the little groove I was going to glue to. and the use 5 min. epoxy. The most time consuming part is cutting the screen. you have to get the shape pretty close and using wire cutter takes time. I use a crayon to mark the screen so I could see it. After I had the screens cut and glued, I did not like the looks of the screen so I decided to paint them. You need to tape them off and paint was not to bad.



At last dark screen, and a protected radiator. The pics don't show it but they are Black gloss.
